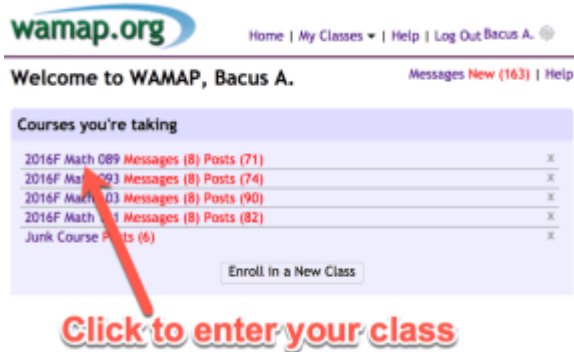


How to find an assigned DQ in WAMAP and respond to it in the DQ thread
